I have driven over 4,000 miles in the past six months on Master-related tasks. In September I will travel to Abilene for the Provincial meeting and in December I will go to Corpus Christi for the State midyear meeting and to Laredo for the Silver Rose handoff across the border.

District Master Fund update

13 Assemblies donated \$2,500 to the District Master Fund this fraternal year. These were a lifesaver! I got caught up and purchased the items needed for the new Exemplification of Patriotism, and I am now operating in the black.

Paperwork

I managed to collect all the audit forms (1315) in July as I did all the officer lists (186) in June. Thankfully, we get a break of forms for a while since the next ones are not due until January.

Installations

In July we did four installations covering five Assemblies. In August two more are scheduled covering four Assemblies. If anyone else wants to add one in August, please let me know ASAP.

Star Assembly

I should have three for 2024-25. Everyone getting their 186 in by 7/1 and their 1315 in by 8/1 are the first two steps for 2025-26. Having a monthly newsletter covers another one.
