2025-26 Star Assembly Award

I have added a file to the Newsletters page showing how I am tracking each Assembly's process, including the 6% membership quota.

Making the quota is one of the requirements; five are paperwork; the other one is that you have regular communication in your Assembly.

The tracker file has three of the seven – the list of officers, the audit, and communication – checked off for every Assembly. The two forms were all submitted by the deadline and if you do not have good communication, you will not complete some of the other requirements.
