This year's awards

Quotas

Billing cycle

I hope everyone is collecting the dues they are owed. If you have members in arrears for 2+ years, and they are not moved to the Affiliate program by their Council (which drops them from your Assembly), you can submit a Form 4 to suspend them for non-payment of dues to get them off your roster if you feel that is appropriate. Avoid doing this before April to allow the billing cycle to complete.

Supreme credit balances

If your Supreme billing statement shows a credit balance (noted with CR under “new balance” in the details), you can email AssemblyCredits@kofc.org and request that it be returned to your Assembly. Of course, if you owe them anything then you should pay it.
